ENROLLING TO VOTE



You must enrol to vote in New Zealand if:

- You're 18 or over; and
- You're a NZ citizen or permanent resident; and
- You've lived in NZ continuously for 12 months or more at some time in your life.

day, Saturday 17 October

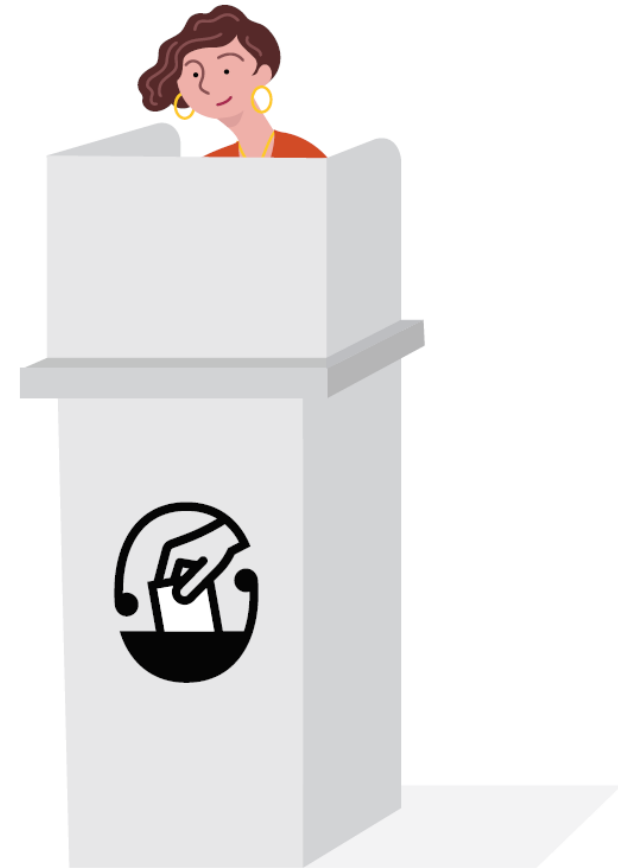

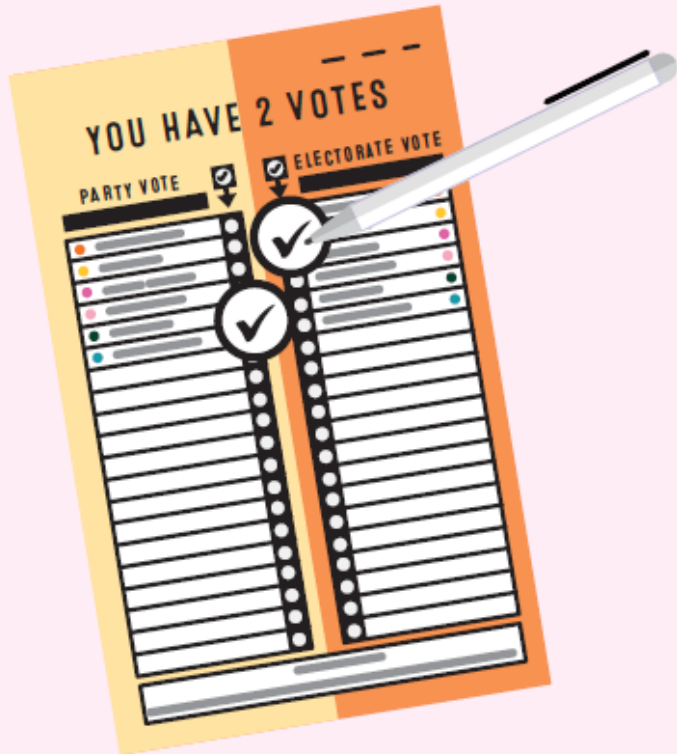

HOW TO VOTE



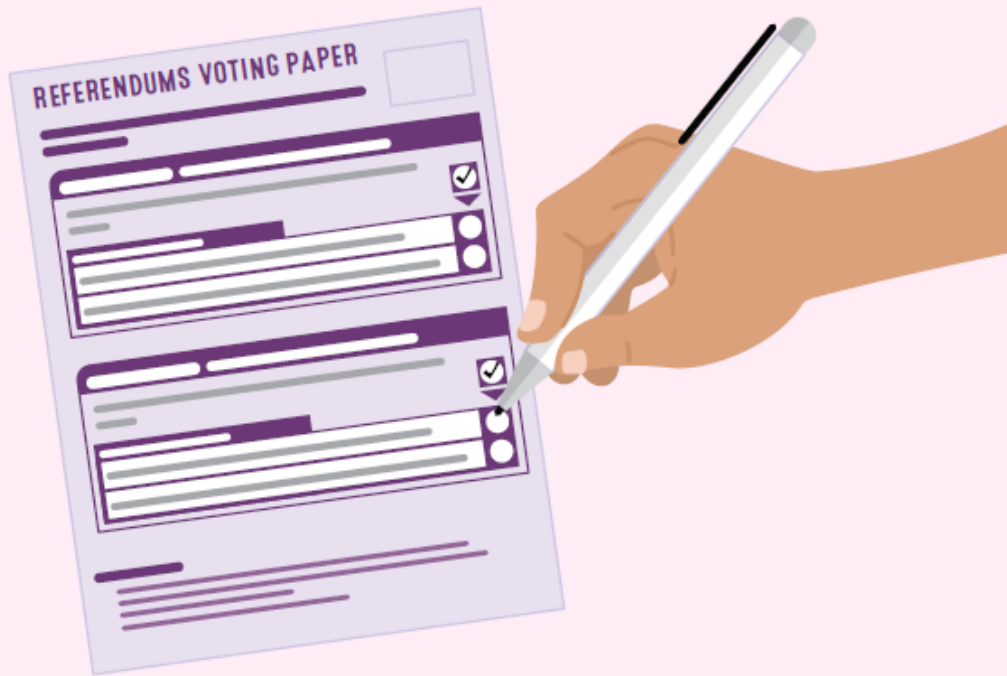
PARTY VOTE & CANDIDATE VOTE

REFERENDUM VOTES

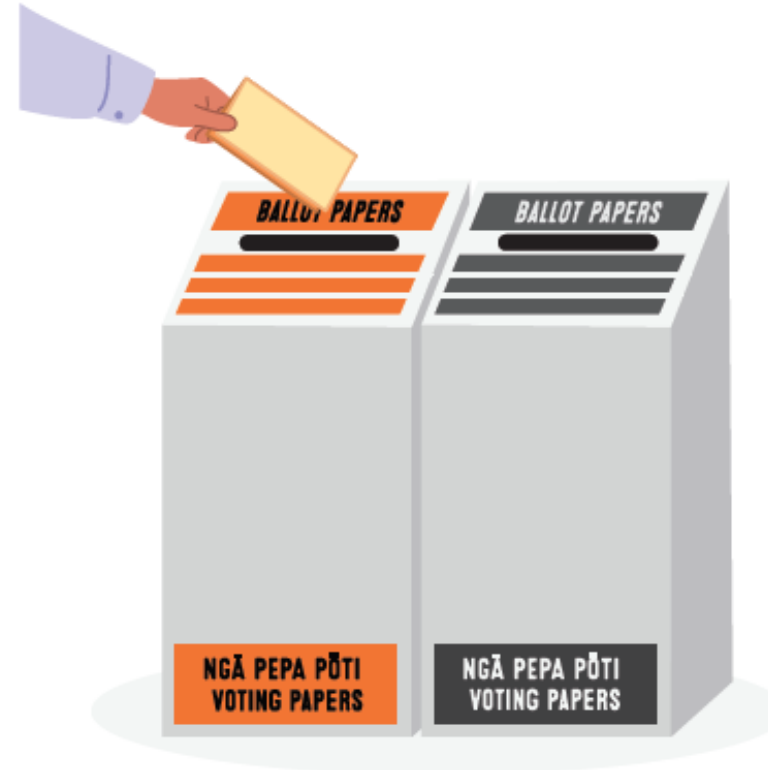


On your voting paper for the referendums put a tick next to your answer to each referendum question.

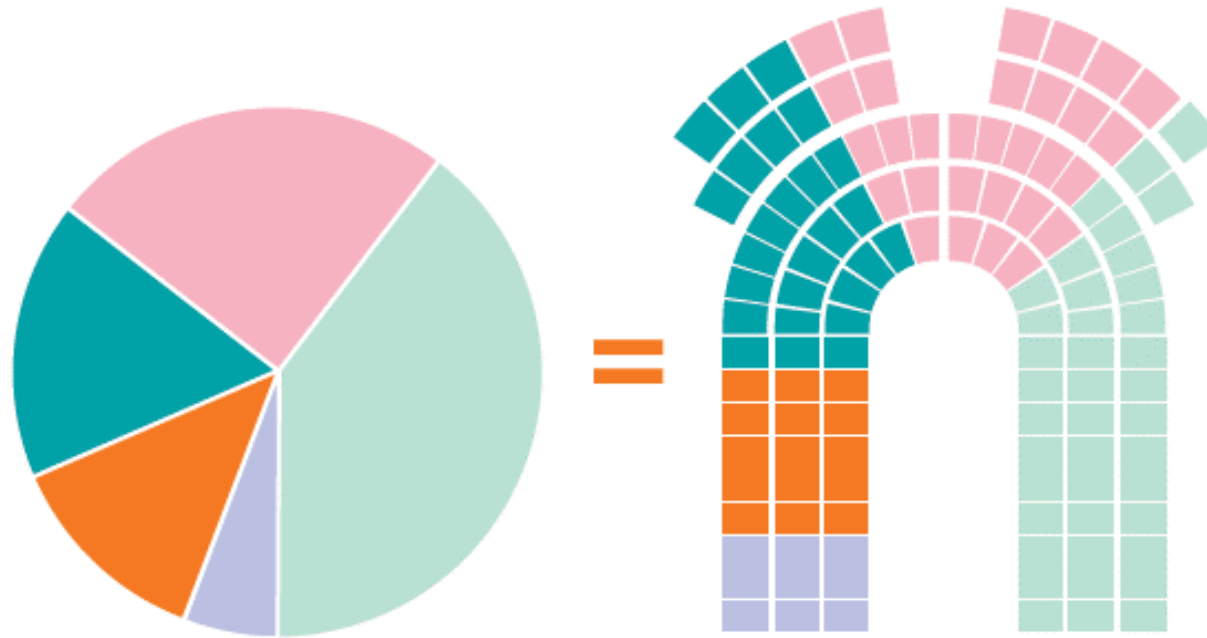
